2026/27 內地大學 升學資助計劃

簡介

「內地大學升學資助計劃」(資助計劃)旨在向前往中國內地修讀學士學位課程的香港學生提供適切的支援,以及確保學生不會因經濟困難而無法獲得專上教育的機會。資助計劃包括兩部分:「經入息審查資助」及「免入息審查資助」。資助款項會按年發放,資助年期為有關學生於指定中國內地院校就讀的學士學位課程的正常修業期。符合資格的申請人只可在同一學年內,接受「經入息審查資助」或「免入息審查資助」二者其一。計劃不設名額上限。

2026/27學年「資助計劃」現正接受申請。「資助計劃」的申請資格、資助金額和申請程序如下:

「經入息審查資助」

申請資格

符合下列資格的學生可申請2026/27學年「經入息審查資助」:

- (a) 擁有香港居留權^{註(1)}或香港入境權,或持單程證來港;
- (b) 在香港接受及完成高中教育^{註(2)};及
- (c) 於2026/27學年,在指定的217所中國內地院校修讀學士學位課程^{註(3)}。

在職家庭及學生資助事務處轄下的學生資助處會為申領資助學生的家庭進行入息審查。

「免入息審查資助」

申請資格

符合下列資格的學生可申請2026/27學年「免入息審查資助」:

- (a) 擁有香港居留權^{註(1)}或香港入境權,或持單程證來港;
- (b) 在香港接受及完成高中教育^{註(2)};及
- (c) 於2026/27學年,在指定的217所中國內地院校修讀學士學位課程^{註(3)};及
- (d)(1) 在香港中學文憑考試(文憑試)考獲「3322」^{註(4)}或「332A」^{註(5)}的成績,即中國語文及英國語文科達到第3級、數學科達到第2級,以及通識教育科達到第2級或公民與社會發展科取得「達標」的成績;
- (d)(2) 通過「香港副學位畢業生升讀華僑大學銜接學位課程試行計劃」升讀華僑大學;或
- (d)(3) 經「內地高校招收香港中學文憑考試學生計劃」下的「校長推薦計劃」入讀中國內地院校。

註:

- (1) 預計於2026/27學年內獲取香港居留權的學生亦可申請。
- (2) 亦涵蓋由香港考試及評核局公布的香港中學文憑考試與考學校名單中的內地港人子弟學校。2026/27學年,深圳香港培僑書院龍華信義學校、廣州暨大港澳子弟學校、廣州南沙民心港人子弟學校及東莞暨大港澳子弟學校的文憑試畢業生只要同時符合資助計劃下「申請資格」所列的其他條件亦可申請。
- (3) 不適用於以下修讀雙學士學位/聯合學士學位課程或任何於畢業時將獲指定中國內地院校的合作院校頒授學士學位的課程/學習計劃的學生:
 - (i) 因應相關課程的安排,於2026/27學年在非指定中國內地院校或香港以外的合作院校就學的學生;或
 - (ii) 先獲香港大專院校錄取,再獲指定中國內地院校錄取至上述課程的學生。
- (4) 適用於2023年或以前獲取的文憑試成績。
- (5) 2024年香港中學文憑考試的公民與社會發展科(公民科)取代原有的通識教育科。公民科的評分標準為「達標」或「不達標」。在舊「達標」或「不達標」的成績將可換算為「達標」或「不達標」。

資助金額

資助計劃下的資助金額會按院校所在地區與香港的距離分為以下三個類別發放:

申請

資助計劃現正接受2026/27學年的資助申請。為了提供更方便的申請途徑,合資格的香港學生可通過教育局的網上申請平台遞交申請(<https://musss.edb.gov.hk>)。符合申請資格的學生須於**2026年9月21日**或之前,透過網上申請平台遞交申請或把填妥的申請表格及相關證明文件以郵寄方式送交:教育局香港筲箕灣郵政局郵政信箱44072號(請註明:「內地大學升學資助計劃」的申請)。

教育局預計於2027年第一季起分階段就申請結果通知申請人。

Mainland University Study Subsidy Scheme

Introduction

The Mainland University Study Subsidy Scheme (MUSSS) aims to support Hong Kong students in pursuing undergraduate studies on the Chinese Mainland and ensure that no students will be deprived of post-secondary education opportunity due to a lack of means. MUSSS comprises two components: "means-tested subsidy" and "non-means-tested subsidy". The subsidy is granted on a yearly basis, and the subsidised period is the normal duration of the undergraduate programme pursued by the student concerned in a designated Chinese Mainland institution. Eligible applicants can only receive either a means-tested subsidy or a non-means-tested subsidy in the same academic year. MUSSS is not subject to any quota.

Applications under MUSSS for the 2026/27 academic year are now invited. Eligibility for MUSSS, the amount of subsidy and the application procedure are as below:

"Means-tested subsidy"

Eligibility

Students meeting the following criteria may apply for the "means-tested subsidy" for the 2026/27 academic year:

- having right of abode ^{Note (1)} or right to land in, or have entered Hong Kong on One-way Permits;
- having received and completed senior secondary education in Hong Kong ^{Note (2)}; and
- pursuing undergraduate studies in any of the **217 designated Chinese Mainland institutions** in the 2026/27 academic year ^{Note (3)}.

The Student Finance Office under the Working Family and Student Financial Assistance Agency will conduct the means tests for the families of the applicants.

"Non-means-tested subsidy"

Eligibility

Students meeting the following criteria may apply for the "non-means-tested subsidy" for the 2026/27 academic year:

- having right of abode ^{Note (1)} or right to land in, or have entered Hong Kong on One-way Permits;
- having received and completed senior secondary education in Hong Kong ^{Note (2)}; and
- pursuing undergraduate studies in any of the **217 designated Chinese Mainland institutions** in the 2026/27 academic year ^{Note (3)}; and
- (1) attained "3322" ^{Note (4)} or "332A" ^{Note (5)} in the Hong Kong Diploma of Secondary Education Examination (HKDSE), i.e. attained Level 3 in Chinese Language and English Language, Level 2 in Mathematics, and Level 2 in Liberal Studies or "Attained" in Citizenship and Social Development; OR
- (2) pursuing studies in Huaqiao University through "Pilot Scheme on the Articulation of Hong Kong Sub-degree Graduates to Huaqiao University"; OR
- (3) admitted to a Chinese Mainland institution through the "School Principal Nomination Scheme" under the "Scheme for Admission of Hong Kong Students to Mainland Higher Education Institutions".

Amount of Subsidy

The subsidy will be disbursed to eligible students based on the distance between the location of their institutions and Hong Kong, which will be grouped under the following three categories:

Application

MUSSS is now open for applications for the 2026/27 academic year. To facilitate submission of MUSSS applications, eligible students can submit their applications via the MUSSS Electronic Application Platform (<https://musss.edb.gov.hk>). Eligible students are required to submit their applications via electronic platform or send the completed application forms and relevant supporting documents by post to Education Bureau, P.O. Box 44072, Shau Kei Wan Post Office, Hong Kong (please specify "Application for MUSSS") on or before **21 September 2026**.

The Education Bureau is expected to notify applicants of the application results by phases from the first quarter of 2027.

Note:

- (1) A student who is expected to receive his/her right of abode within the 2026/27 academic year also apply.
- (2) To also cover schools for Hong Kong children on the Mainland listed under the HKDSE Participating School List published by the Hong Kong Examinations and Assessment Authority. For the 2026 academic year, HKDSE graduates from Shenzhen Hong Kong Pui Kiu College Longhua Xinyi School, Affiliated School of JNU for Hong Kong and Macao Students, Minxin Hong Kong School (Guangzhou Nansha) and Affiliated School of JNU for Hong Kong and Macao Students (Dongguan) are eligible provided that they also fulfill other criteria listed under "Eligibility" of MUSSS.
- (3) Not applicable to the following students enrolled in dual/joint bachelor's degree programmes or course/study programme leading to the award of a bachelor's degree by a partner institution designated Chinese Mainland institution upon graduation:
 - who are studying in non-designated Chinese Mainland institutions or partner institutions outside Hong Kong under programme arrangements during the 2026/27 academic year
 - who were first admitted by Hong Kong post-secondary institutions and subsequently admitted to designated Chinese Mainland institutions for the aforementioned programmes.
- (4) Applicable to HKDSE results obtained in or before 2023.
- (5) The Citizenship and Social Development subject replaced the original Liberal Studies subject in 2024 HKDSE. The scoring criteria for the Citizenship and Social Development subject is "Attained" and "Not Attained", with "A" representing "Attained". The HKDSE results obtained in 2024 or later have been revised to be "332A".
